GENERAL INFORMATION

Cell Power® Calcium Platinum is a water-soluble foliar nutritional fertilizer of macro and micronutrients. It is designed for foliar application and may be applied alone or in tank mixes containing pesticides. However, when use of an unfamiliar mix is made, a compatibility test is always recommended. Foliar fertilization is a supplement to a regular fertilizer program and will not supply the total nutrients required by a crop. Cell Power® Calcium Platinum is recommended as a foliar nutrition to be applied to crops where disorders due to insufficient calcium are anticipated.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Add approximately 1/2 of the required amount of water to the spray tank. With agitation running, add Cell Power® Calcium Platinum to the spray tank. Continue agitation while adding the remaining required water. Maintain agitation until all of the mixture has been sprayed. Add Calcium Platinum to the spray tank before adding pesticides. Do not store solution mixed with pesticide.

SUGGESTED USE RATES

CROP - RATE/ACRE - NUMBER & TIMING OF APPLICATIONS

Apples: 1-4 guarts/acre. 5 applications starting at petal fall. Combine with cover sprays. Almonds: 1-4 quarts/acre, 3-4 applications from green bud through jacket split. Asparagus: 1-4 quarts/acre. Apply as needed through the growing season.

Avocados: 1-4 quarts/acre. Multiple applications.

Broccoli: 1-4 quarts/acre. 4-6 applications starting shortly before bead formation.

Brussels Sprouts: 1-4 quarts/acre. Multiple applications.

Cabbage, Cauliflower, Lettuce, Endive: 1-4 quarts/acre. 4-6 applications starting shortly before head formation.

Caneberries and Blueberries: 1-4 quarts/acre. Make a total of 3-4 applications. May be made in conjunction with pesticide sprays.

Chinese Cabbage: 1-4 quarts/acre. 2-4 applications per season.

Celery, Chicory: 1-4 quarts/acre. Weekly applications starting before black heart symptoms

Cherries, Plums: 1-4 quarts/acre. 3-4 applications starting 6-8 weeks before harvest. Cotton: 1-4 quarts/acre. 3 applications between 5-7 leaf stage and flowering

Cucumbers, Melons, Peppers, Tomatoes: 1-4 quarts/acre. 6-12 applications during fruit

Hops: 1-4 quarts/acre. Make applications early during flower formation and continue as needed IN through the growing season.

Onions/Garlic/Leeks: 1-4 quarts/acre. Multiple applications during growing season.

Potatoes: 1-4 quarts/acre. Multiple applications during periods of heat stress.

Strawberries and other berries: 1-4 quarts/acre. 3 applications in conjunction with last preharvest pesticide sprays.

Grapes: 1-4 quarts/acre. 3-4 applications from beginning of berry softening to maturity.

Table Grapes: 1-4 quarts/acre. 3-4 applications from beginning of berry softening to maturity. Kiwi: 1-4 quarts/acre. Multiple applications.

Pears: 1-4 guarts/acre. Multiple applications.

Peaches and Nectarines: 1-4 quarts/acre. 4-5 treatments beginning from fruit-set. Turfgrass: 1-4 quarts/acre. Multiple applications during growing season.

For all turf uses, do not apply near water, storm drains, or drainage ditches. Do not apply if heavy rain is expected.

Ornamentals: 2-4 applications weekly, stopping at the stage of bract colorations. Poinsettia: 1-4 applications weekly, stopping at the stage of bract colorations.

For aerial application use a maximum of two (2) quarts of Calcium Platinum per 10 gallons water. Rates recommended are for standard soray volumes of 150 galloge.
